National Fire Prevention Week 2019 is October 6-12. To promote the importance of fire safety, HAI Group partners with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and local fire departments to sponsor an annual Fire Safety Poster Contest.

This year's FPW campaign, "Not every hero wears a cape. Plan and practice your escape!" educates residents about the importance of planning and practicing their exit strategy in the event of a fire.

HAI Group encourages young residents to talk with their families about creating an escape plan. They should learn two ways out of every room and make sure all doors and windows that lead outside open easily and are free from clutter.

We invite young residents to create posters about this year's theme, "Plan and practice your escape!"

2019 Fire Prevention Week Fire Safety Poster Contest

Help your young residents showcase their artistic talents and win prizes by encouraging them to create posters centered around the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) theme of "Not every hero wears a cape. Plan and practice your escape!"

HAI Group members will be reimbursed for the prize money you award to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd-place winners. To be eligible for reimbursement you must:

- Email or fax the attached registration form no later than September 27, 2019.
- Use the theme established by the NFPA and conduct the poster contest during Fire Prevention Week, October 6-12, 2019. All posters must be original. Participants may use the following: markers, paints, crayons, and colored pencils. No stenciling or tracing is allowed. Standard-size poster board/paper (22"x28"), if available, should be used.
- Establish three age groups:*
 6-9 10-14 15-18
- * You may establish different age groups (maximum of three) to ensure equal participation among resident children. Please document changes with a letter or e-mail to HAI Group.
- Establish three prize categories for each of the three age groups:

1st place: \$50 (maximum) 2nd place: \$30 (maximum) 3rd place: \$20 (maximum)

(Total amount of prize money per agency is \$300. One individual cannot receive more than \$50.) Only three winners are allowed per age group. (NO TIES.) \$100 limit per age group.

- Submit the names and addresses of the winners from each prize category and age group and a listing of all participants to HAI Group. All participants will receive a certificate from HAI Group recognizing their achievement.
- Winners must be photographed next to their poster. All photos (not posters) must be submitted to HAI Group before we will reimburse your agency for the prize money.
